Old Palace Celebrates Exam Success

Old Palace students achieved a very good set of results at A Level this year (2022) with around 50% of grades at A*-A, including 16% at the top A* grade.

93% were placed at universities of their own choosing with 7% deciding to take a gap Year (or applying in 2023). Just under 60% secured a place at one of the prestigious Russell Group universities and 2 students were successful in securing places at Cambridge University.

What was really pleasing was the wide range of high quality courses that Old Palace students have started this autumn, very much reflecting their skills and talents.

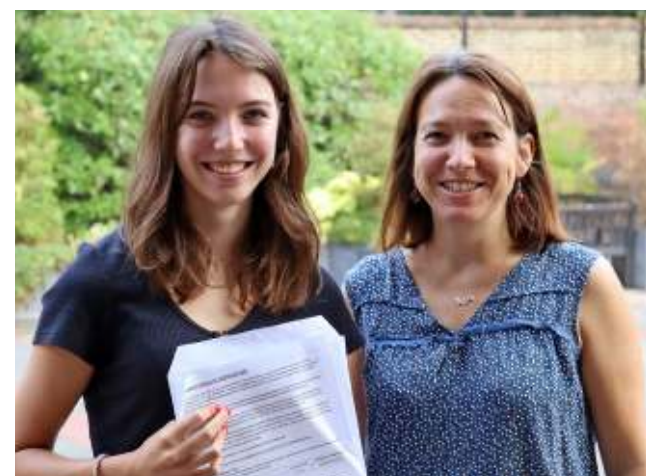
Mrs Burton, Head, sent the following message to students on the day of the results:
